Designated Scholarship Information

- 1. The designated scholarship can be set up in the name of a person, family, business, or other entity. Your contribution can also be anonymous.
- 2. The minimum donation amount for a designated scholarship is \$10,000. There is no limit on the maximum amount of a donation.
- 3. Scholarship donation paperwork must be filed by November 1st for student spring awarding and fall usage. Scholarship monies must be received no later than December 31.
- 4. The donor determines the longevity of their scholarship.
- 5. Scholarship awards can be split between semesters.
- 6. Donors will receive notification and a thank you letter.
- 7. If there are no qualified candidates, the money will carry over the next year's process.
- 8. Relatives of a designated scholarship donor are ineligible for that particular scholarship.
- 9. The ACA Scholarship Trust Committee determines the scholarship winners.
- 10. Student are made aware of scholarship opportunities through ACA Scholarship Website at acascholarshiptrust.org.
- 11. All donations are tax deductible according to 501 (c) (3) in the United States).
